The Valley is designed as a suicide deterrence film about a father's journey to find answers in the wake of his daughter's suicide.

When affluent Silicon Valley entrepreneur Neal Kumar’s daughter, Maya, tragically dies by suicide during her freshman year of college, no one seems to know why. In his frantic quest to find the truth – and as his seemingly idyllic life and family begins to unravel – Neal discovers many things about himself and his own choices.

Audiences have said they found it “haunting,” “gripping,” “moving,” and “couldn’t take their eyes off the screen.” The film has been in 25 film festivals all over the world, has earned 11 awards and 19 nominations.
